Children Services Opens new FCCS East Office, 4071 E. Main St., Whitehall

FCCS Executive Director Chip M. Spinning and the Franklin County Commissioners have opened a new Children Services facility at 4071 E. Main St. in Whitehall for more than 400 employees.

The 96,000 square-foot structure will combine the staffs of three current FCCS regions into one facility with expanded parking and visitation facilities in a workable “green” family friendly environment.

“We are proud to have this opportunity to display a modern office complex in a prime location that will provide easy access for the children we serve, their families and our partners,” Spinning said. “Purchasing this building will allow us to consolidate our staff and eliminate current leases at 525 E. Mound St. (Central and Intake regions) and 205 N. Hamilton Road, formerly known as the East Region.” Those two offices will be closed.

All East, Central and Intake and Investigations activity will now occur at the new building. There will be no change in the FCCS West Region office at 1919 Frank Rd. or the administrative offices at 855 W. Mound St.

Bids for the property were identified through an RFP process beginning in April 2011. The Daimler Group served as project builder with architectural plans drawn by the firm of Moody Nolan. Construction on the \$17 million project took 11 months.
