## Children Services to Launch Redesigned Website

FCCS is extending its reach with a new sleek, and state-of-the art version of our website, [childrenservices.franklincountyohio.gov](http://childrenservices.franklincountyohio.gov).

The site's modern mobile-responsive design, search features and user-friendly layout was prepared to attract new users and enable to us to spread the message of child abuse awareness and prevention further than ever before.

With the new design, each page adjusts to fit the screen size of the device on which it's being viewed, enabling PC, laptop, cell phone and tablet users to access information in the same way wherever they are, said Deborrha Armstrong, Communications Director for FCCS.

“We want to make it easier and more efficient for anyone searching for us to find us, our information and our services in keeping with the mobile-friendly society we live in,” Armstrong said. “Our staff and the Franklin County Data Center have worked together for the public to see a seamless transition on May 2.”

The site also features an updated color scheme and simplified [site navigation](#), making it easier to find the information and services needed to protect children and strengthen families. Users are able to search by using multiple terms and partial matches will return results (e.g. “child,” will return items with “child and children”).
