PURPOSE: <i>Employee is under supervision of Building Maintenance Supervisor; installs, repairs, inspects and maintains air conditioning, refrigeration and heating systems; liaison between agency and contract staff by providing work direction for emergency services which may include scheduling and monitoring of on-site repairs. The employee will help the agency achieve CFSR standards and help ensure service delivery that focuses on Safety, Permanency and Well-being for the families served by the agency. JOB DUTIES:			
<i>55%</i>	<i>Inspects and repairs air conditioning, refrigeration and heating equipment and systems, including the use of building automation system to monitor and adjust equipment. Performs scheduled maintenance such as clearing or changing filters, lubricating motors and pumps, tightening belts, and air quality tests. Utilizes diagnostic equipment to assess equipment function. Advises Building Maintenance Supervisor of assessed need for major repairs by outside contractors, makes contacts to schedule repairs, liaison with on-site repair personnel and ensures repairs transpire.</i>		
<i>20%</i>	<i>Repairs other equipment such as refrigerators, ice machine, washers, dryers, dishwashers, pneumatic consuls, stem traps, pressure regulators, steam separators, pumps, fans, motors.</i>		
<i>10%</i>	<i>Performs plumbing repairs to faucets, sinks, toilets, and drinking fountains and unclogs drains.</i>		
<i>10%</i>	<i>Plans and schedules work priorities; maintains records of work performed, both written and computerized.</i>		
<i>5%</i>	<i>Performs other related duties as assigned.</i>
