Franklin County Children Services is seeking a full-time child welfare casework supervisor in our Adoption department. This position serves as the assistant deputy compact administrator in carrying out the responsibilities involving Interstate Compact Placement of Children requests. Also responsible for training all levels of staff and managed care entities regarding ICPC. This position is also responsible as the Agency liaison to the Dave Thomas Foundation for the Wendy's Wonderful Kids program. Position is responsible for managing a team of staff providing quality service delivery to the children by evaluating potential adoptive homes, preparing culturally diverse youth and families for adoption, facilitating the adoptive process, coordinating and providing clinical and administrative guidance to staff. Minimum requirements are a MSW or related master's degree in social work plus three years post child welfare casework experience; or a BSW or related bachelor's degree in social work plus four years post child welfare casework experience. LISW and adoption assessor certification preferred. Strong supervisory skills and experience and knowledge of adoption and child protection policies, procedures and rules are required. Must demonstrate cultural awareness, sensitivity and a commitment to meeting organizational goals. Preferred candidate will have adoption assessor certification and ICPC knowledge.
