

Nurse Supervisor

Franklin County Children Services is seeking a Nurse Supervisor to help serve youth involved with the child welfare system. The applicant will supervise registered nurses and a secretary. The employee will provide medical case consultation to casework staff; complete medical screenings of children; visit client and foster homes as needed; submit written assessments and recommendations; review and approve medical consents for children in FCCS custody ; ensure required coordination so special needs children receive necessary medical care; administer TB tests for FCCS staff; assist with filling prescriptions for FCCS youth; and work with Medicaid Managed Care Plans and insurance companies for prior authorization, denial and planning to ensure the youth in custody receive medical services. The employee will oversee scheduling to ensure nursing coverage for the various agency needs.

This position requires a sound knowledge of nursing practice, exceptional leadership abilities and problem solving skills. Must be detailed oriented, highly organized, efficient, and have excellent communication/writing skills. Current licensure as a registered nurse (RN) in the state of Ohio and six months of supervisory experience or equivalent is required. Bachelor's degree in nursing, pediatric nursing experience and strong supervisory experience are preferred.
