

CHILD WELFARE CASEWORK SUPERVISOR-PLACEMENT DEPARTMENT

Franklin County Children Services is seeking an energetic child welfare casework supervisor for the Placement Department. This position primarily supervises Placement Staff responsible for locating kinship placement options for youth in agency custody. Responsibilities include: equitably assigning home study requests to staff; collaborating with assigned placement caseworker and service teams; when necessary, providing direct and indirect services in absence of placement caseworker; communicating with potential/approved kinship caregivers, creating solutions for placement issues; approving material assistance/financial requests, ensuring efficient data entry into SACWIS for all designated home study and placement activities; reviewing completed home studies; making home study and placement decisions; preparing kinship cases for transfer to Ongoing Kinship team; advising Placement team on policies and procedures; and ensuring compliance with agency and ODHSS requirements.

Requirements are an MSW or related master's degree in social work plus three years of post-child welfare casework experience; or a BSW or related bachelor's degree in social work plus four years of post-child welfare casework experience. LISW preferred. Commitment, passion, strong leadership, supervisory skills, and experience, as well as knowledge of child protection and rules are required. Must demonstrate culture awareness, sensitivity and a commitment to meeting organizational goals. This is a 40-hour position with hours primarily being 2nd Shift, 2 p.m. to 10 p.m., Monday-Friday.
