

CHILD WELFARE CASEWORK SUPERVISOR

Franklin County Children Services is seeking a Child Welfare Casework Supervisor for an Intake & Investigation position with our Screening department. This is a full-time 40 hour position (four 10 hour shifts primarily between 10 a.m. and 10 p.m.) This will be a flexible schedule and include some weekend coverage. The position is eligible to receive the agency's off-shift differential pay. The incumbent would be responsible for making screening decisions and managing a team of screening caseworkers providing quality intake service delivery to the children and their families who are served by the Agency. Requirements are a MSW or related master's degree in social work plus three years post child welfare casework experience; or a BSW or related bachelor's degree in social work plus four years post child welfare casework experience. LISW preferred. Supervisory experience and knowledge of CAPMIS/SACWIS, child protection policy and rules are required.
