

Maintenance Worker/Groundskeeper

Franklin County Children Services is seeking a Maintenance Worker/Groundkeeper for the maintenance department. The applicant will plant and maintain turf, trees, shrubs and flowers. They should possess the ability to apply pesticides, insecticides and fertilizers. The candidate will perform snow and ice removal from walkways and roadways, often during off-shift or overtime hours. They may perform carpentry work; repair and replace locks; make spot roof repairs; move office cubicles; install and finish drywall; patch plaster; and prepare surfaces for painting. The incumbent may service Agency vehicles by checking oil, changing filters, replacing bulbs, installing spark plugs, and replacing windshield wipers. The preferred candidate will be a high school graduate with the ability to read and follow instructions. The incumbent must have a valid driver's license and a minimum of two years of maintenance experience including knowledge of carpentry. Excellent communication, organization, and writing skills; respect for cultural diversity and a demonstrated commitment to cultural sensitivity are expected.
