This role also acts as the lead supervisor between FCCS and the Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption in regards to the Wendy's Wonderful Kids program housed at the agency. Requirements are a MSW or related master's degree in social work plus three years of post-child welfare casework experience and an adoption assessor certification; or a BSW or related bachelor's degree in social work plus four years of post-child welfare casework experience. LSW preferred. Must be able to work varied hours including occasional out of state travel. Commitment, passion for children and families, strong leadership, supervisory skills, and experience, as well as knowledge of child protection and adoption rules are required.
